Attendance

Each school in NSW has an attendance target. Our school target for 2024 is 93.7%.

Currently our attendance rate sits at 90.5%, which is wonderful and something everyone should be proud of. It would be great if we could maintain this. Every day does count.

It is important that students come to school each day. The evidence is clear that consistent attendance is the essential first step for your child to have a positive school experience.

Every day matters for your child's learning. Missing school means missing new work being introduced or consolidated, time with friends and special school events. Often parents don't realise how a day off here or there can impact a child and their learning. Students are required to attend school every day, whether it's the first or last day of the term, Mondays, Fridays, or days dedicated to sports carnivals, school excursions and incursions. - Sibling Photos Don't forget to pre-order your sibling photos online up to 24 hours before photo day. We provide your school with a list of sibling orders right up to the day of photography, so no one misses out. Sibling photographs only apply to children enrolled at your school.
- Late fees A late fee will be applied to each package purchased after photo day due to the additional cost of producing these packages separately.
- Package delivery School photographs will be returned approximately 6 weeks after the day of photography.
 Please note this delivery timeframe is dependent on proofing and additional photography days at your school.
- Previous Years' photos Past years' photographs including sports, co-curricular and representative groups are also available to order under the "previous years or group photo" tabs at your school's advancedorder site when you click on the "Order School Photos Here" button above. You can also order past packages, portrait images and gifts from your child's unique, individual and secure advancedyou image archive site using the unique 9 digit image code found on packages you have ordered in the past.




