This week we had a special visit from our Police Youth Liaison Officer – Senior Constable Ethan West. For Kindergarten and Stage 1 students, his message was about how to stay safe in the community and around road ways. Officer West also emphasised safe and respectful playground behaviours which aligned with our school expectations.

Stage 2 and Stage 3 students had a wonderful time learning from Officer Ethan about cyber safety and the impact of their digital footprint. He strongly emphasised ways for our students to stay safe online and what students should do if they experience online safety concerns. To conclude, he reminded our students that the online world requires respectful behaviours, just as they would use if talking face to face with a peer in the playground or classroom.

There was much excitement at the end of each learning session as students were treated to a close-up inspection of a police vehicle. The flashing lights and a quick burst of the siren were the best!

May we ask if you are paying cash for your child's order or sending spending money, where possible please send coins or smaller value notes. We have limited change available and struggle to change large notes of a morning.
