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SN Term 4 Overview

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to full time face-to-face learning! As an overview of our school programs and activities for the term, I would like to outline the following:

Term 4 Overview:

English – Students read and understand text focusing on *Fact and Opinion*; explore different types of text and identify each whether the text is a fact or opinion. In Writing, students engage with different purposes of the author – *Persuade, Inform and Entertain*. In phonics and spelling program, students engage with High Frequency Words, Grapheme Phoneme Correspondences, Vocabularies, Synonyms, Antonyms, Prefixes and Suffixes.

Mathematics – Students apply appropriate mental and written strategies and digital technologies to solve multiplication word problems; conduct chance experiments; use appropriate unit and device to measure; numbers with decimal points (tenths and hundredths); different types of angles; describe locations on grid-referenced maps; solve word problems that involve addition and subtraction of fractions with similar denominator.

Science – Material World – Students observe the effects of heat on the properties and behaviour of materials; observe properties of materials and determine their use for a range of purposes; feedback on investigations to answer questions and summarise data to communicate conclusions; use materials, tools and equipment to develop solutions for a need or opportunity.

Physical Development and Health– Making Healthy Choices - Students will gain a greater knowledge of how their personal choices in relation to health and active lifestyle influence their lives. **PE** - Students set themselves challenges and work to achieve personal movement goals through manipulation of sports and games within the class.

Creative Arts – Dance: Following sequences, steps and movements; Craft: Famous Art Works.

Class Sports Program –Sports adapted games – Fundamental Movements skills

The Life Skills Framework will continue this term focusing on Personal Health Choices, Daily Living and Independent Work Skills.
