2023 School Swimming Carnival

Dear Parent/Carer

Our 2023 Years 3-6 School Swimming Carnival is being held on Thursday 23 February at Macquarie University Sport and Aquatic Centre. Children turning 8 years old enrolled in Year 2 are also permitted to attend.

Students will be travelling by bus, departing from school at 9:00am, returning at approximately 2:45pm. Students should wear their sports uniform with swimmers underneath, ready to compete. Students must provide their own sunscreen and pre-apply, prior to the carnival. No coloured zinc or face paint is permitted.

Students should bring all food and drinks required as canteen/vending machines are not available. No glass bottles or glass containers are permitted in the venue. The cost per child is \$35.00. If your child is absent from school on the day, the cost still applies, and no refunds will be permitted.

Please note that this year's carnival will be **competitors only** and **only students who are entering races will be attending**.

For students choosing to compete, parents are required to fill out the online form asking you to select the races your child wishes to compete in. This form can be accessed through the link or QR code below. Each student must have their own form completed in order to compete at the carnival. The online form **will not** be accepted as permission. The permission note attached must be signed and returned in order for your child to participate in the carnival.
